Please gather the following and send it to us. Also, if you want to add to your answers that you gave in the office, please let us know.

- 1. Create a timeline which summarizes the major events in date order. Doctors and hospitals have their version of the events in the hospital charts and doctor charts. We need your version. For example:

1 Jan 2001 - went in for hip replacement

7 Jan 2001 – went to rehab

2 Feb 2001 - called Dr. Jones re pain, left message, did not get call back.

- 2. List all employer names, addresses, dates employed for last 10 years.
- 3. List names, addresses and specialties of hospitals, physicians and other healthcare providers that you sought treatment from for the last 10 years.
- 4. List names and addresses of family, friends, employers, co-workers, professors/teachers, clergy, physicians, therapists (physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy), or any other witnesses that know about the event or can show how you were affected by the event. If you "connected" with any health care providers and think they will help you in this claim, put a star next to their name.
- 5. List all insurance coverages. This includes Medicaid; Medicare; Automobile; Group Health; Social Security; Disability; Unemployment; ADC; or any Government Assistance Program. We need the dates of eligibility and the exact names of the plans, Parts A,B,C,D, how much they've paid.
- 6. Is any family member disabled? How?
- 7. Do you get SS, SSI, SSDI, food stamps, or been denied any?

**We need the following. If you don't have it, write down "None".**

- 8. Tax returns for the last 5 years.
- 9. Marriage certificate.
- 10. Autopsy report, death certificate, if applicable.
- 11. Any documentation to show that you lost income from the event and how much, like receipts or pay stubs before and after the event.
- 12. All medical bills for treatment related to the event and afterwards.
- 13. Any written timeline of events that you or a family member may already have kept, such as a diary or journal.
- 14. Phone records (cellphone and land line) showing phone numbers called.
- 15. Photographs from before the event that show action, enjoyment, family.
- 16. Photographs taken after event: injury sites, scars, family showing sadness.
- 17. Photographs taken when you were at your worst after event (in hospital or soon after).
- 18. Videos showing you (birthday party, graduation, wedding, family reunion).
- 19. Awards, certificates, licenses, degrees that you have received.
- 20. Media coverage regarding this event or that mention you such as television reports, newspaper articles, and magazine articles, websites, weblogs.
